



Year 3 and 4 - Term 1 2022 Learning Overview

'Footprints from the Past'

This term, our Topic focus is 'Footprints from the Past' in which we are learning about The Stone Age to The Iron Age. To support our Topic learning, we will be reading 'Stig of the Dump' within our Literacy learning.

In Geography, we'll be learning about:

- Locating key Stone Age settlements and rivers in the UK
- How Stone Age people used their land and comparing this to how we use our land in the Modern Day
- How agriculture and transport developed through The Stone Age

In History, we'll be learning about:

- How artefacts can tell us about Pre-historic life
- How early Stone Age man lived, and how Britain changed throughout the Stone Age
- The changes from the Stone Age to the Iron Age

In Science, we'll be learning about:

- How human teeth are designed to break down different foods
- How the human digestive system works
- Ask relevant questions and use scientific evidence to answer them

In Art, we'll be learning about:

- Improving our mastery of art techniques
- Develop techniques for using coloured pastels
- Create sketch books to record their observations.

In Physical Education, we'll be learning about:

- Take part in outdoor and adventurous activity challenges both individually and within a team
- Swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres.
